MULTI-SPORTS with Ignite Sports

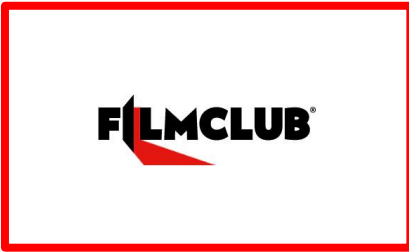
Y1- 6
