Key Areas of Learning

As **Geographers** we will be looking at the immediate area of Aston. We will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds and the key physical features of its surrounding environment. In addition, we will devise a simple map and use and construct basic symbols in a key.

As **Historians** we will be look at the life of Queen Victoria and her contribution to national achievements.

As **Scientists** we will be investigating our bodies. By the end of the topic we will be able to name, draw and label some body parts. In addition, we will be learning about our five senses and the body parts related to each sense.

As **Artists** we will be working predominantly on the colour wheel, using paint to investigate what happens when we mix two colours together. This will lead into learning about primary and secondary colours. Following this we will construct a movable bear using split pins.

ENGLISH

In English this term we will be studying traditional tales and our focus story will be 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. We will learn this story and adapt it, using our own innovations.

In addition to our Talk for Writing topics, we will continue to have daily phonics through the Read, Write, Inc. programme.

MATHEMATICS

In Maths lessons we will be counting and comparing numbers to deepen our understanding. Furthermore we will look at our number bonds to 10 and begin to add and subtract to make different numbers. We will also begin to complete word problems.

We will continue consolidating other areas of the Maths curriculum through Math Meetings.

PE

In PE we will be learning large ball skills with Mr Hook. In dance we will be choreographing our own routines to a piece of music. Working with a learning buddy, we will copy and repeat actions.

RE

In R.E. we will be learning about the Creation story.

We will think about how God would like us to look after the world.

COMPUTING

We will be studying a topic called 'Treasure Hunters' which will cover simple programming.

MUSIC

As musicians we will be learning to use our listening skills to decipher different sounds and different instruments.

PSCHE

In PSHCE we will deepen our understanding of our monthly values Appreciation and Respect and our SEAL topic is 'New Beginnings.'

FRENCH

In French we will be learning to count to 10 and learn how to greet each other.
